

Prom 2011 Guidelines

These apply to everyone, BMCHS Students & Guests:

By purchasing your Prom ticket(s) you agree to follow BMCHS regulations.

Also, if you are purchasing a ticket(s) for someone else, it is your responsibility to ensure that he/she receives, reads, understands, and agrees to abide by these regulations.

PERSONAL APPEARANCE (taken directly from the school handbook)

These rules are in place for prom in addition to the Special Prom Rules.

BOYS are to be clean-shaven at all times. Hair must be cut in a conservative, traditional fashion; hair cut over the ear and one inch above the collar in back. Boys are not permitted to wear earrings.

GIRLS: Proper undergarments must be worn. Bra color should blend with the clothing color or skin color of the wearer. Excessive make-up is not permitted.

JEWELRY must be conservative. Body piercing, tattoos, beads, link chains, extreme hair styles, and all other symbols of a counter culture are never permitted.

The administration reserves the right to judge the acceptability of a hair style/color and general appearance. Outlandish or fad styles will not be accepted for either boys or girls. If unacceptable, students may be sent home immediately.

SPECIAL PROM RULES

1. Prom is a BMCHS function and all school rules found in the code of conduct apply.
2. All students attending Prom must arrive by 7:30PM. Failure to be on time will result in refusal of admission and a phone call to parents.
3. Once admitted, all individuals must remain at the dance until 11:30PM. No exceptions. While at the dance, any behaviors deemed inappropriate by chaperones (i.e. unacceptable dancing, sitting on another's lap, etc...) will not be tolerated.
4. Students may not reserve rooms at Disney's Swan/Dolphin Resort.
5. This is a formal event, therefore all students must be appropriately dressed.

Girls:

- ~No bare midriffs
- ~No slits past 4 inches above the knee
- ~No backs lower than "your natural waist" – smallest part of your waist
- ~No cleavage may be showing
- ~No hems more than 4 inches above the knee

Boys:

Dress shirt and tie with a suit or tuxedo.

6. Alcohol, drugs, and tobacco products are not to be used or possessed before, after, or during the dance. Administration will pursue any means of investigation necessary to assure compliance with this policy.
7. Forms for non-BMCHS student guests **MUST** be submitted to the Deans' Office no later than Friday, APRIL 15, 2011. No guest will be admitted without the required paperwork submitted **ON TIME**.
8. No guests over 19 years of age are permitted to attend prom.
9. No guests under 15 years of age (must be a sophomore) are permitted to attend prom.

Failure to comply with the dress code or any regulation will result in a phone call home to parents, refusal of admission, and possible disciplinary actions.
