Academic Support Services

- Classroom Accommodations
 - Individualized based on documented need
- Progress Checks
 - Regular grade monitoring and meetings based on progress
- Classroom Support
 - In partnership with classroom teacher to address challenges
- Goal Setting
 - Help students set realistic goals and strategies to achieve them
- Collaboration
 - Communication & collaboration with students, teachers, parents



BMC Classroom Accommodations

- Students with documented learning differences / challenges
- Individualized and reasonable based on BMC resources and documentation
- Not obligated to provide all services or recommendations
- Students are expected to complete all assignments and graduation requirements.



Standardized Testing Accommodations

- BMC accommodations do not guarantee standardized testing accommodations
- Must be approved by testing company
 - College Board = PSAT, SAT, and AP
 - ACT Services = PreACT and ACT
 - 2 companies = 2 different processes / approvals
 - Specific documentation required



Standardized Testing Accommodations

- College Board (PSAT, SAT, and AP exams)
 - Eligibility starting freshman year
 - May request at any time
 - Each exam has deadline
 - Parental consent form required
 - BMC submits request and documentation online
 - Once approved, accommodations apply to all College Board exams



Standardized Testing Accommodations

- ACT (PreACT and ACT exams)
 - Accommodations requested with test registration
 - PreACT BMC registers students
 - ACT students register themselves
 - Parental consent form required
 - BMC submits request and documentation online
 - Once approved:
 - PreACT year by year
 - ACT accommodations apply to future ACT exams



Accommodations in College

- Myth: College is a continuation of secondary education with the same services / accommodations
- Laws governing accommodations are different
 - ADA focuses on accessibility
- Federal Education Rights to Privacy Act
 - Students are considered adults.
 - Staff and faculty are only permitted to discuss the student's educational information with the student.
- Research each colleges policy and procedure when determining a good fit
