Purpose of College Visits

- Very important and fun part of college exploration
 - Gain first hand experience with the college.
 - Does the college feel like a good fit for your student?
 - Can decide whether or not to keep college on your list.
- 3 types of college visits
 - In-person tour
 - Virtual tour
 - College visits at Bishop Moore

In-Person Campus Visits

- Research colleges prior to visit
 - Sports tournaments, vacations, etc.
- Schedule tour on college's website
- What to expect from a tour?
- Prepare questions in advance
- Talk to current students at the college

In-Person Campus Visits

- Eat in dining hall, visit library & dorms
- Check out bulletin boards, newspapers
- Explore campus on your own after tour
- Explore surrounding community
- Keep notes and photos of your visit



Encourage student to ask questions that are important to them!






- Popular majors?

- Popular activities and clubs?
- ☐ How many students live on campus?
- □ Why did you choose to attend this college?
- □ What do you wish you could change about this college?
- □ Dining options?
- □ Support services?



Bishop Moore College Visits

- Over 100 colleges and universities
- Chance for students to meet admissions representatives
- Research colleges to see if they're a good fit
- Sophomore through Senior students are eligible to attend
- Visits listed in Naviance (Colleges, then college visits)
 - Must register 24 hrs in advance
 - Get teacher permission
- Prepare questions in advance
- Take notes





Virtual Campus Visits

Great way to visit a lot of campuses, especially out-of-state

- Links to virtual tours on Naviance or college's websites
 - YouVisit- can filter by campus traits
 - The College Tour tv show
- Some tours are student-led
- Virtual reality options
- Academic departments
- Keep notes about your observations
