### GRADING SYSTEM

Yearly and cumulative weighted GPAs are indicated on student records. **BMC neither ranks nor provides percentile estimates.**

### CURRICULUM

Bishop Moore Catholic High School offers a competitive college preparatory curriculum with a focus on academic excellence. Courses are offered at the Dual Enrollment, Advanced Placement, honors, and college prep levels. BMC is not on a block schedule. Students in the Class of 2024 must successfully complete 26.0 high school credits. This may vary if a student transferred to BMC.

Courses completed prior to students entering 9th grade at Bishop Moore Catholic will be noted with an #. These courses neither count in their BMC GPA nor in their required credits for graduation.

### ADVANCED PLACEMENT COURSES

Bishop Moore Catholic offers Advanced Placement courses in Art, Biology, Calculus, Chemistry, Computer Science, Economics, English, Environmental Science, French, Geography, Government, History (American, European and World), Latin, Music Theory, Physics, Psychology, Spanish, and Statistics. AP placement is based on grades, teacher recommendations, and standardized test scores. All AP students are required to sit for the AP exams in order to receive AP credit.

### DUAL ENROLLMENT COURSES

The Class of 2024 has the opportunity to take four Dual Enrollment courses in theology in conjunction with Barry University and four in aeronautics in conjunction with Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University.
