

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING AT HOME LEARNING

Parents/Guardians:

This afternoon Governor DeSantis announced that Florida schools will remain closed for the remainder of this academic school year. The schools in the Diocese of Orlando will follow this same directive. Therefore, Bishop Moore Catholic High School will keep all school facilities closed for the remainder of this year while continuing forward with "At Home Learning".

Preparing for many different scenarios, we have been working on a variety of options, in consultation with the Diocese of Orlando, Office of Schools for end of the school year events, especially for the Class of 2020.

We will share these options with you as soon as we are ready, but please keep in mind that there are still many things that need to be considered; not the least of which being social distancing directives and any additional information from our diocesan and government officials.

For students in grades 9<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup>, the last official day of instruction will be Thursday, June 4, 2020. Final exams will be replaced with virtual instructional days.

Most Seniors will complete their academic year on Friday, May 15, 2020. The exception being those Seniors scheduled to take any AP exam that have been rescheduled by the College Board after May 15<sup>th</sup>.

Although we are still unable to be on campus with one another, we remain focused on our mission to serve our students in the best way possible as they grow in virtue and knowledge. As people of certain hope, we look forward to the day when we will once again be proudly wearing our black and gold as we, together, walk our beautiful campus.
