Campaign Guidelines: Campaigns will be completed in an ethical and respectful manner. If the following guidelines are abused or disrespected, it could result in disciplinary action or removal from running.

1. The student must collaborate with Mr. Devilien, Associate Director of Student Life, and Mr. Jimenez, Digital Services Coordinator, to develop posters.
2. The student is required to create a platform in which it would be shared through official BMC communications channels and social media platforms.
3. Poster must include the candidate's name and the date of the election.
4. Posters must only be hung in approved areas.
5. Clearly articulate the vision and goals for the Student Government and what positive changes you will seek to make.
6. Do not promise the obviously unattainable.
7. Highlight your relevant experience, skills, and qualifications that make you a suitable candidate for the position.
8. Emphasize your willingness to collaborate with other student leaders, faculty, and administration to achieve common goals.
9. Campaigning negatively towards another candidate is not allowed.
10. The poster and speech must demonstrate how the individual will be beneficial to the school without referencing inappropriate or unnecessary details.
